

## NEDLAC EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

**TARGET:** To hold four meetings in the year under review. The discussions should be of a strategic nature on issues of national priority. There should be high-level delegations from all four constituencies.

### Programme Performance

The Executive Council met three times in the year under review. One Executive Council meeting was postponed resulting in the next scheduled meeting not taking place because of its proximity to the previous one.

The 23rd meeting of the Nedlac Executive Council was held on 19th July 2002. This was postponed from 31 May at the request of the constituencies. The meeting was chaired by the Minister of Labour, Membathisi Mdladlana. The focus session was on NEPAD, and the meeting was addressed by the Minister of Trade and Industry, Alec Erwin. The Council also approved the financial statements of the organisation at this meeting.

The 24th meeting was held on 9 November 2002, immediately prior to the Nedlac Annual Summit. It was chaired by Fadila Lagadien for Community. The Nedlac Annual Report was taken as read, and the Council reviewed the activities that had taken place during the course of the year.

The 25th meeting of the Executive Council was held on 28 February 2003, and was chaired by Attie du Plessis for business. The Minister of Finance, Trevor Manuel, gave a presentation on the National Budget for 2003/04, which had been tabled in Parliament two days previously. The constituencies further discussed the forthcoming Growth and Development Summit.
